# Ventura County Public Health Dept. GUIDELINES

All Ventura County schools have prepared detailed reopening procedures that will help ensure the safety of students and staff when they return to campus. They include:

- Staff and students will prescreen for symptoms on a daily basis.
- Face coverings will be required for all staff and for students.
- Keep students and staff appropriately physically distanced.
- Students will be kept in stable groups at all elementary schools.
- Middle and High School students will have limited transitions and have assigned seating for classes to ensure that students are around the same students in each class.
- Parents will be instructed to keep students home whenever they have a temperature or show symptoms.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms at school will be sent home.
- Facilities and equipment will be disinfected on a regular basis.
- School officials will work with Ventura County Public Health on contact tracing when positive cases arise.
- Athletic training and conditioning are allowed with physical distancing, games are being played with guidance from public health officials.
- Staff will receive COVID-19 testing as required by state and local regulations.

## Small Group Parameters:

Students will attend a minimum of two days a week, attendance will be taken daily.

- Connect students to online tutoring support (i.e. tutor.com)
- Provide optional SEL/Community Building resources
- Encourage students to complete all outstanding assignments/homework
- Connect students to online supplemental programs for skills practice
