FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ▶ Students will be required to wear masks, check in at assigned entry point, and have their temperature checked



WHAT WILL COMING INTO SCHOOL
IN THE MORNING LOOK LIKE?



- ▶ Students will go to one classroom and stay there with their small cohort (12 students max) for 3 periods
- ▶ When the bell rings, the teachers will change classes if necessary (7th and 8th), students will stay in their seats and not move classes



WHAT WILL MY CLASSES LOOK LIKE?

- ▶ Teachers will be teaching “simultaneously” to those students in class and the rest of the class that will be at working at home, on Chromebooks-everyone gets the same lessons



HOW WILL WE BE LEARNING IN CLASS?

- ▶ Teachers will be teaching “simultaneously” to those students in class, if you are absent, you will log in as usual from home and are responsible for the work



WHAT IF I CANNOT COME TO
SCHOOL AND I AM ABSENT?

▶ Students will be given a snack after 1st period that they will eat with their small cohort of students in one location

▶ Lunch will be “grab and go” and will be given to students as they leave school around 12pm-**no lunch at school**



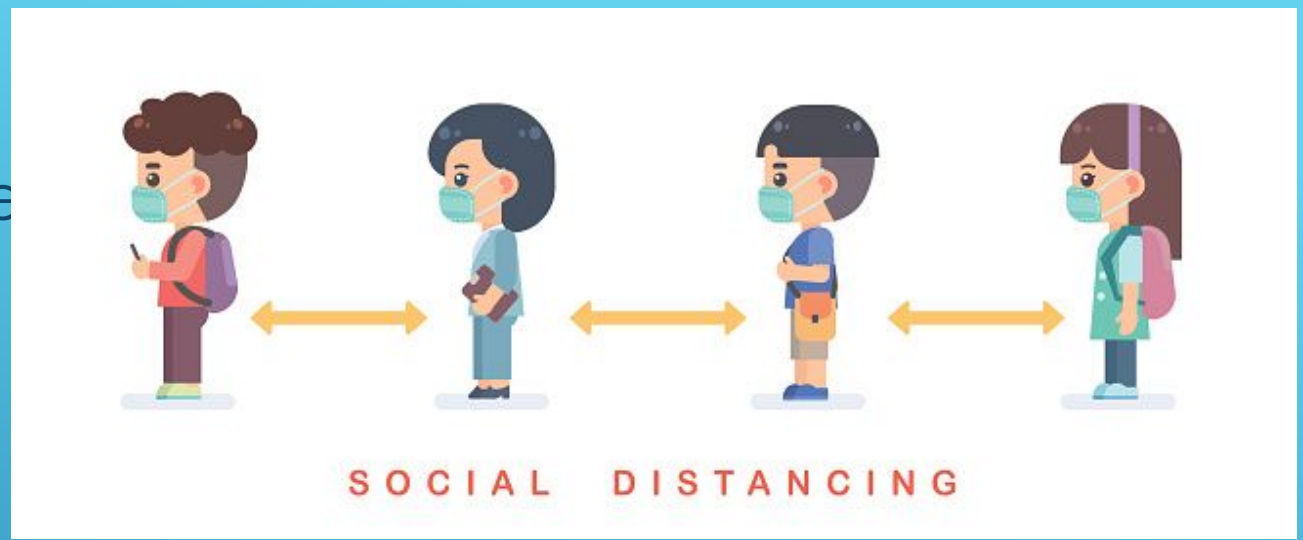
WHAT WILL NUTRITION AND LUNCH LOOK LIKE?

- ▶ If students need to use the restroom, they will be allowed inside one at a time and the bathrooms will be cleaned between each use



WHAT WILL RESTROOM BREAKS LOOK LIKE?

- ▶ Students will be released to go home after 3rd period
- ▶ Those that are walking home will head straight out the nearest gate and must leave immediately following the arrows
- ▶ Those getting picked-up will wait in the quad 6 feet from other students until their ride shows up
